APPENDIX

METHODOLOGY FOR STATE/REGIONAL TOURISM FORECASTS

Tourism Research Australia (TRA) uses a hybrid approach to forecasting both domestic and international visitor nights at the state and territory level in the following order:

- (1) First iteration: The forecasting team generates total international and domestic visitor nights largely consistent with TRA's national tourism forecasts.
- (2) Second iteration: For international visitor nights, historical shares of each market and each travel purpose for states and territories are calculated to derive a trend function to estimate shares over time. With the estimated shares, visitor nights are forecast for each state and territory and aligned to forecast visitor nights at the national level.
- (3) Third iteration: The preliminary forecasts of domestic visitor nights are adjusted on the forecast weighted gross state product (GSP); a major income driver of state/regional tourism forecasts. The inclusion of the forecast weighted GSP captures the dynamics of intra state and interstate economic activities (a proxy for income effects) driving the state tourism forecasts.
- (4) Final iteration: The total state tourism forecasts are further adjusted to incorporate external factors such as sporting and business events scheduled in each state and territory.

Note: The gross state product (GSP) forecasts are provided by external economic forecasting agencies. The forecast weighted GSP is estimated for forecasting purpose only, and is the average of GSP of origin states/territories proportioned by travellers of origin states visiting a particular state/region. For example, in the case of forecast domestic visitor nights in Victoria, 58 per cent of visitor nights are generated by residents in Victoria, 17 per cent by residents in NSW and 25 per cent by residents of other states and territories. Based on this information, the weighted GSP is calculated as summation of 58 per cent of GSP from Victoria, 17 per cent of GSP from NSW and 25 per cent of GSP from other states and territories.
