Singapore Airlines SQ288: twin-city itinerary

- Singapore Airlines' daily SQ288 service operates to the following schedule:

Flight Number and Routing	Days of Operation	Time of Departure	Time of Arrival
SQ288 Singapore-Sydney	Daily	10:30	20:10
SQ288 Sydney-Canberra	Daily	21:20	22:20
SQ288 Canberra-Singapore	Daily	23:15	05:15+1

- A passenger originating and terminating in Singapore, with a single ticket itinerary of SQ288 SIN-SYD-CBR-SIN, has the right to stopover in Sydney and/or Canberra (for a period of time determined by the terms of their ticket) before joining SQ288 SYD-CBR-SIN (if they have chosen to stopover in Sydney) and/or joining SQ288 CBR-SIN to complete their journey.
- A passenger originating and terminating in Singapore, with a single ticket itinerary that includes any of the following SQ flights to Sydney – SQ211/SQ221/SQ231/SQ241 SIN-SYD, followed by SQ288 SYD-CBR-SIN, has the right to stopover in Sydney and/or Canberra (for a period of time determined by the terms of their ticket) before joining SQ288 SYD-CBR-SIN (if they have chosen to stopover in Sydney) and/or joining SQ288 CBR-SIN to complete their journey.
- A passenger travelling from other global ports on any SQ service into Singapore can also stopover in both Sydney and Canberra, provided SQ288 is included in the itinerary as per the above options.
- A passenger stopping in both Sydney and Canberra would firstly disembark and clear customs in Sydney for their stay there. When travelling onto Canberra, they would board SQ288 from Sydney International Terminal and fly SYD-CBR. They would disembark in Canberra for their stay, before joining SQ288 from Canberra International Terminal to complete their journey.
